Ever since (15 years) he has continued to assist with the set up and running of PN Volleyballs Leagues, helping run Tournaments, and was a Valuable member of the Team that ran New Zealand Secondary School Nationals in Palmerston North up to 2017.

He has also been our Mr Fixit (Build It) doing any repairs we have needed at the Arena Manawatu including building equipment from scratch as we have needed. Peter has also been helping the schools in the area with their equipment repairs as required. He is a valued member of the team that runs Volleyball in the Manawatu for the last 15 years."
